The 2019 workshop will begin **Monday, August 5, 2019** and conclude on **Friday, August 9, 2019** with a performance for family and friends on the final afternoon of the program. The daily schedule is **9 AM to 4 PM** with an hour break in the middle of the day for lunch. Daily rehearsals and coachings will be balanced with other musical workshops and outdoor activities. The goal of the Envision Chamber Music Workshop is to celebrate the joy of music-making in a supportive environment that inspires musical and personal growth. Students will receive coaching from young performers and educators including Josie and Sophie Davis, Maya French, Colin Wheatley, and more.

ELIGIBILITY

This five-day program is open to string, piano, flute, voice and clarinet individual applicants as well as pre-formed ensembles. Students should be between the ages of 8-18, though exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis. We are excited to open the program to young students at a beginning-intermediate level this year. In addition to regular chamber music coaching, age-appropriate group activities will be integrated into the week.
